#### EUPEN: what? when?

- consortium of ~ 130 Physics Departments in Universities/Technical Universities in almost 30 different European countries
  - + some 5 European/national professional org. associated
- ► Thematic Network Project in ERASMUS of SOCRATES from DG EAC of E.C. (support ~ 150 k€/a)

### **EUPEN**: why? who? which products?

- offers a forum for discussion of physics degrees
- 5 working groups (each chair, secretary, 3 members); one on ICT!
  - + executive committee: determines *EUPEN* policy
  - + permanent secretariat at Ghent University
- series of annual Gen. Fora: Brugge (1997), Dublin (1998), London (1999), (regional) Lille, Poznan & Barcelona (2000), Köln (2001)

with proc. 'Inquiries into European Higher Education in Physics' 6 vol.

### Harmonisation of HE in Europe (I): the paths (i)

- evolution last quarter of century: massification & democratisation
- EU no important competencies (2 articles in Amsterdam Treaty)
   mobility & co-operation programmes

(ERASMUS, LEONARDO, TEMPUS, SOCRATES)

- continental universities -> internationalisation interest:
   recruitment of foreign students
   mainly by creation of two-years MSc programmes in English(!)
   (e.g. in DE with support of Heraeus Stiftung)
- equivalence of diplomas: NARIC

### Harmonisation of HE in Europe (I): the paths (ii)

- tension: unitary system (UK, ES, & SE)
   vs binary system (other EU) for HE
- change in degree system: FR 'mastère' (5 yrs) (prereq. for doct.)
   IT 'laurea' (3 yrs) + 'laurea specialistica' (2 yrs)

NL: in sciences & appl. sc.: 3 + 2 yrs ( $\beta$  convenant)

- 3 MSc options: research; communication & education; management
- debate on globalisation of HE at GATS of WTO:

### **Bologna Declaration & 'Process'**

- a common (29 -> 40 countries)
   action programme (not a political statement)
   to create a European space for HE by 2010
- a set of five specified objectives and measures
   with organised implementation via the 'Bologna process'
  - common framework of qualification: readable degrees
  - undergraduate / postgraduate levels in all countries (Ba min. 3 yrs)
  - ECTS compatible credit system
  - European dimension in quality assurance
  - elimination of obstacles to free mobility of all students & teachers

### **EUPEN's ongoing contribution (I)**

*'Tuning educational structures in Europe'* project (½M€) *Rijksuniversiteit Groningen* (NL) and *Universidad de Deusto* (ES)

- aims: enabling (~100) 'EU' universities in joint debate on
- \* professional profiles and needs for society
- \* how to measure student workload by ECTS as accumul.system
- \* adaptation to new labour market and learning outputs
- focused on five core disciplines: mathematics, geology, business, history and educational sciences in synergy with two TNPs: physics (*EUPEN*) & chemistry (*ECTN*)
- **anticipated outcome:** *e.g.* methodology in Europe-wide tuning of educational structures applicable to other areas
